Self Catering Accommodation

Aigas nestles spectacularly between the peaceful River Beaully and the Aigas Forest.

Our 550 acre family run estate is the ideal base to enjoy the complete Highland holiday experience.

Four courtyard cottages and one secluded hillside cottage are traditionally built.

All have been carefully refurbished, double glazed and thoughtfully equipped.

Laundry and games room are adjacent to the courtyard cottages.

Cuil Na Caillich (sleeps 5 + cot)

Cosy hillside cottage in a secluded setting.

Enjoys a lovely South facing aspect overlooking the glen.

Lounge, fully fitted kitchen/dining area.

3 bedrooms: 1 double, 1 twin, 1 single, shower room/wc.

Attached outbuilding with laundry facilities.

Coach House (sleeps 6 + cot)

Spacious and very comfortable, occupying the west wing of the courtyard.

Lounge, fully fitted kitchen/dining room, bathroom/wc with over-bath shower and bidet.

First floor - 3 Bedrooms: 1 double, 2 twins, wc.

Pond View (sleeps 6 + cot)

Attractively furnished first floor courtyard cottage with good views over the golf course and forest. Accessed by external stone steps.

Lounge/dining area, fully fitted kitchen.

3 bedrooms: 1 double, 2 twins, bathroom/wc with over-bath shower.

Old Dairy & Old Stable (sleeps 4 + cot)

Two charming courtyard cottages similar in size.

Spacious and comfortably furnished.

Lounge/dining room with fully fitted kitchen area.

2 bedrooms: 1 double, 1 twin, shower/wc.

Golf

Our own 9 hole parkland course is a great challenge for golfers of all levels and visitors can play here at almost any time.

The courtyard cottages are just over 100m to the first tee. Guests enjoy special discounts on normal green fees. Club, trolley and buggy hire are available.

Within a radius of 40 miles, another 25 courses can be played, including Royal Dornoch, Nairn and Castle Stuart making Aigas a great base for golfers.

Outdoor Activities

The natural beauty of the area provides a spectacular back drop for many other popular activities such as walking, bird watching, dolphin spotting, cycling, canoeing, mountaineering, fishing and pony trekking.

Visitor attractions

Numerous local attractions include:

- The Inverness Aquadome (with flumes and wavepool).
